





Diamonds are sourced with utmost care maintaining the high quality as a benchmark as it is synonymous with the brand Hazoorilal.









Tanzanite traces back to north Tanzania in the year 1967 and the name has been derived from its place of origin.







The gifting of jewellery in Indian wedding trousseau is a tradition passed down in families for generations.


Polki uncut diamond jewellery is an integral part of the marriage ceremony. A bride is styled to dress traditionally on the main wedding day.









Gold jewellery has come a long way since its initial patterns of designs.


The increasing need of innovation has motivated the brand to showcase newer and exquisite collections in the gold segment.


A piece of art curated with unimaginable workmanship. The set brings out the beauty of a peacock and its colourful plumage of blue and green in sheer gold.

A bold statement set with a single bracelet is carved to complete details with the peacock. A full projecting peacock ring is a show stopper.












detailing to be seen. The earrings styled in traditional jhumka pattern are classy and keep the flow of the designing aspects thorough.
